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**Mathematics:** 3 credits, Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II are required—4 or more recommended.

- Statistics Dual Enrollment (MTH 157) \*\* HS and college credit. Algebra II & Pre-Calculus are prerequisites; Calculus is strongly encouraged and can be taken concurrently.

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**Foreign Languages:** For the Class of 2018, Latin I is required plus 3 years of another language or 2 years of 2 languages (one of which must be Latin) or 3 years of Latin. For the Class of 2019 and subsequent classes: Students must take (a) 3 years of Latin or (b) 1 year of Latin and 2 consecutive years of the same modern language. However, 3-4 years of a single language are recommended. A 77%+ average is required in the previous level to proceed to the next level of a language.

- Intermediate Band – Students improve skills in preparation for two concerts, Christmas and spring. Prerequisite: minimum of one year of experience or director approval. Instrument: \_\_\_\_\_ (\$15 fee)
- Advanced Band – Students will progress to higher levels of performance in preparation for two concerts, Christmas and spring. Prerequisite: minimum of two years of experience or director approval. (\$15 fee)

- Chorus – Students will sing popular, traditional, and sacred music in preparation for two concerts. (\$20 fee)
