

The Seton School Theatre Letter and Theatre Honors Pins Program

Seton School now offers Letters and Honors Pins in Theatre! This is great for your college resume as well as a wonderful way to celebrate your participation in arts programs at our school.

Students grades 9-12 are eligible for the program. All requirements must be fulfilled during your high school (9-12) years, and it is grandfathered to previous years if you are an upperclassman.

To earn a Letter in Theatre:

- The eligible student will actively participate in a meaningful way in two of Seton's many theatrical programs: The Fall Play, the Improv Troupe, the Spring Musical and the Theatre Seminar.
- A "meaningful way" means that the student has shown a strong commitment to their role in the show... meaning, a lead, an ensemble cast member, a member of stage or tech crew, art crew, or assisting the production staff. Each applicant will be approved by the appropriate production's adult lead to ensure they fulfilled their individual commitments (Mrs. Vander Woude for Spring Musical, Mr. Moore for Fall Play, Improv and Seminar, Mr. Mooney for Technical and Backstage).

To earn an Honors Pin:

- An Honors Pin in Theatre is earned with the successful completion of two additional theatrical productions (as described above).
- To apply, the student will follow the same method as per the Theatrical Letter.

To Apply:

- It is incumbent on the student to apply for these honors. Send an email to honors@setontheatre.com to apply. In this email, list your name, grade, productions you have been a part of at Seton and what your role was.

Students may apply and receive honors at any point during the school year. However, to be recognized at this year's Theatrical and Fine Arts Awards Night on May 19th, your email will need to be sent no later than Monday, May 8.
