

THE POWER OF SILENCE: Here is the third installment from Father Morey's faculty retreat:

So, what is silence? I looked it up in Webster's online dictionary. To say that silence is the absence of sound doesn't tell us what it is. Part of the problem is that we simply can't reduce "silence" to one concise sentence-long definition. It's impossible because silence is more powerful and mysterious than that. An amazing book, published only last year, is called *The* Power of Silence, by Cardinal Robert Sarah, an African cardinal, currently serving in Rome as the Prefect of the Congregation for Divine Worship. I'm getting absolutely no royalties or "cut" from promoting this book. But let me tell you: it'll change your life. The introduction itself will draw you in. Without a doubt, it's the most compelling introduction I've ever read in my entire life. Ten pages of sheer genius, guaranteed to pull you into the story. And the funny thing is, it's not even written by the Cardinal or by a Church prelate. It's written by the French interviewer, Nicolas Diat, who clearly has learned something about silence by observing the man he was interviewing. The interview highlights the spiritual friendship of Cardinal Sarah and a young Carthusian brother in France, whose illness had deprived him of the ability to speak. How can one build a personal and intimate friendship in only a few short visits with a bedridden person who can't even speak? Well, you'll have to read the book to find out. But here's a hint: their friendship is built on the power of silence.
