

Parents,

As we begin our 2017-2018 athletic season we would like to inform you of a few things that are taking place in the athletic department.

Firstly, we are trying to provide all teams with the appropriate athletic shorts. We are in the process of purchasing shorts for every team whose uniform includes shorts, but the process will take some time to complete. Athletes must wear the shorts that are provided with their uniform. We are trying to ensure that we purchase enough sizes so that no Athlete should have to purchase or use their own shorts. If your child is not comfortable with the size they are provided they should speak with the coach. On a case by case basis, they may receive approval to wear non-uniform provide shorts, but those shorts must have a 5-inch inseam or longer.

Secondly, we would like our jerseys to last for several years. Therefore, we ask that you please take care of this borrowed equipment as much as possible. When washing jerseys, we ask that you please;

- a. Do not wash the jersey on its own. The machine agitates that particular item and it will encourage the lettering and numbers to come off of the item.
- b. Do not put the jersey into the dryer. Hang Dry. The heat from the dryer again encourages the lettering and numbering to peel off.
- c. Do not use fabric softener when washing.
