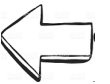

# Important DATES, NOTES and COSTS:

## Important Dates:

- Rehearsals will be on Wednesdays and Saturdays starting Saturday, January 20th. If you have many conflicts on these days, the musical might not be the activity for you! Seton sports are not conflicts.
- Tech Week begins Monday night April 2<sup>nd</sup> and continues every day. Entire cast will need to be present for Tech week rehearsals. If you have any questions/concerns, please email Mrs. Erin Vander Woude.
- There will be NO rehearsals during the Easter Triduum: Holy Thurs. - Easter Mon. 6 pm. Tech week starts then.
- Performance Dates are: Friday, April 6 at 7 pm; Saturday, April 7 at 7 pm; Sunday, April 8 at 3 pm. The following weekend is Friday, April 13 at 7 pm and Saturday, April 14 at 7 pm. Strike will be on Sunday afternoon at 1 pm. All cast members are expected to attend strike.
- There is a required parent's meeting on the first rehearsal day: Saturday, January 20<sup>th</sup> from 9 - 10 am. Students will stay until noon. Please mark it on your calendar now.
- Please see the attached calendar and WRITE IN any conflicts and turn that in at your audition.

## Other important notes:

- All pertinent information about the musical will be at SetonMusical.com such as schedules, ticket sale hours, costume descriptions, etc.
- If a student will unexpectedly miss a practice for any reason, an email must be sent to Erin Vander Woude. Any absence without an email to Mrs. Erin Vander Woude will be unexcused.
- If a student has more than 2 unexcused or 3 excused practices, we may have to revisit their role in the musical.
- We follow the handbook on rules about behavior and dresscode. (Please reread pages 28 onward) Dresscode highlights include: Modest and appropriate jeans, shorts, and t-shirts allowed. No skinny jeans or leggings. Shorts must be below fingertip length. All shirts must have sleeves. (No tight clothing, bare midriffs, lowcut or see through tops, or clothing with inappropriate words, symbols or pictures.).
- Leave all electronics home, and tuck cell phones away to use only to call home for rides. Bring homework or a book for down time.
- Students must stay on the premises in the designated practice areas. And please leave our practice areas better than we found them.
- Parents, please drop off and pick up in a timely fashion for the sake of our volunteers.
- The musical survives on volunteers. Please jump in and help! It is very rewarding. Every parent must chaperone a performance and every student must help with the strike.

## How much does it COST to be involved in the musical:

- Participation fee: \$15.00 per student (\$30 family max)
- Strike/Chaperone deposit: \$50 CHECK. This will be returned on Sunday after the strike if your student participates in the strike and a parent helps chaperone the performances.
- Costumes: you may have to acquire new or thrift store items for your children. We try hard to keep these costs low.
