New students must take the Math Placement Exam. Calculators are not allowed. The test is about 90 minutes long. Please bring two pencils.

## **Elective Courses: Choose one elective below. Remember to indicate 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> choices.**

**Note that priority in enrollment in High School level courses is given to High School students. Class space considerations may limit your choices.**

- Life Skills (Boys)** - Low pressure course that is a mixture of fun and learning. Organization and study skills, team building, school service, carpentry, money management, car mechanics, games/exercise in gym.
- Life Skills (Girls)** - Students will learn important life skills such as gratitude, friendship, study skills, cooking, sewing, working with the elderly, first aid, babysitting skills, communication, public speaking and more. Service projects will be an integral part of the class.
- Beginning Band**-No experience required; learn basic skills needed to read and perform band music in preparation for two concerts. Some instruments available for loan (see Miss Erwin). Instrument: \_\_\_\_\_ (\$15 fee)
- Intermediate Band** – Prerequisite: minimum of one year of experience or director approval. Students improve skills in preparation for two concerts, Christmas and spring. Instrument: \_\_\_\_\_ (\$15 fee)
- Chorus** – Students will sing popular, traditional, and sacred music in preparation for two concerts. (\$20 fee)
- Study Hall** - Quiet study in study hall or back of ongoing class if no scheduled study hall available

**Foreign Language** – Latin is a full credit high school class. Your grade in this class will be on your permanent high school transcript. Only the very disciplined student should even consider this workload. A grade of 77% or higher is required in the language to move to the next level.
