After the 8:30 Mass and novena, the students will process to the Blessed Mother statue in the Courtyard for the coronation and the Rosary. We will then re-turn to school, where the schedule will pick up at that point (about

the end of first period). In case of inclement weather, the coronation will take place in the John Paul II Center.
