Seton's John Paul II Center (aka gymnasium) is the largest single space of Seton property. As a multi-purpose facility the JP II Center is in near constant use day and night for a wide variety of functions. Lighting equipment in the space is 25 years old and is dim, inefficient, and has operating characteristics that have to be worked around. A few of these limitations are: lights require 3-5 minutes to warm-up or restart, and cannot be dimmed.

More Than Light – Also Improves Aesthetics

All that's about to change. In its most significant effort to date of continuing improvements to the John Paul II Center, the Seton Athletic Boosters Committee will be replacing later this year the outdated lighting with today's technology: a high intensity, very energy efficient LED lighting system. And these lights have instant off and on capabilities and are dimmable. Here are a couple of many instances where these new lights will improve and enhance the aesthetics of so many functions. SJPII Center lights will now be able to:

- Dim house lights to a low setting for events on stage allowing audience to navigate around.
- Dim lights for events such as a school dance, Friday Mass, or annual retreat.
- Turn off lights for a dramatic spotlight introduction such as a National Honor Society Induction ceremony or announcing starting players at a basketball game and instantly back on again.
- Flash lights at the end of the musical intermission to signal return to your seats.

Certainly a consideration of the Athletic Boosters Committee was how this new lighting will brighten the gymnasium for sporting events. Nevertheless as the SJPII Center is the most used space at Seton, the functional improvements of these new lights will enhance the atmosphere of every event there.
