PRO Point Commitment. For anyone not familiar with how PRO Points are calculated, below is a summary of each family's commitment for the school year.

- PRO Dues are \$25/family (due with required fees).
- Each family is required to obtain **100 PRO Points** during the school year:
 - Volunteering: The value of volunteer hours is **5 points per hour**.
 - Buyout: The cost to "buyout" unearned PRO Points is \$2/point. For example, if you choose to pay for all required PRO Points, the total cost would be \$200.
 - Donations: If you donate food for approved events, you can count the time spent baking/cooking as volunteer hours, and you can count money spent on ingredients towards the \$2/point calculation.
