## FROM THE DIRECTOR



**O**PENING MASS: Our annual Opening Mass is Saturday, September 15 at 11:00 AM in the John Paul II Center. A reception will follow in the Corpus Christi Center, St. Faustina multipurpose room. Our pastor, Father Lee Roos, is the celebrant. We ask that each family bring a plate of finger foods for the reception. We also ask that you bring non-perishable food items for the All Saints Bethany Food Pantry. We make this donation of food each year as a token of gratitude to All Saints for all that the parish does for Seton. Dress code is Sunday best. I look forward to seeing you there.

**MONDAY MASS:** We remind you that Monday Mass begins at 8:30 at All Saints, and we ask the students to arrive no later than 8:20. This week, about 30 students arrived after Mass began. Parents who drive, please leave early enough to get to Mass on time. If your students drive, then make sure they leave in plenty of time. It is disruptive to everyone else and disrespectful to Our Lord when people arrive late.

**THE SUFFERINGS IN THE CHURCH:** Again, I recommend [fathermorey.com](http://fathermorey.com) and encourage you to read his homilies for the 21st and 22nd Sundays in Ordinary Time. The Holy Father, bishops and priests continue to stress the necessity of prayer and fasting.

**MEN OF THE SETON COMMUNITY:** One of the most powerful prayers is Our Lady's Rosary. During this crisis we need to turn to the Rosary and beg Mary's intercession. Each Thursday evening from 7:30 to 8:00 PM in the Seton chapel, we have a men's Rosary and Divine Mercy Chaplet. Of course women can also attend, but it is crucially important that men take the leadership as God calls them to do. A half hour out of the week is very little to ask to offer this powerful prayer for this supremely important intention.



**FAMILY ROSARY:** The family Rosary also works wonders, not only in praying for the needs of our Church, but also in strengthening the family against all the attacks against it. Our children need this spiritual strength. More on this devotion in a later Sentinel.

**HUMANAE VITAE, FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY:** Last week we demonstrated that Protestants used to be just as firmly against contraception as Catholics. When discussing this issue with your Protestant friends, you can also show them Scriptural evidence that God wants us to be life-giving, since Protestants stress that Scripture is their only authority. Some examples: In Genesis 1:28, immediately after the creation of male and female, the inspired author tells us, "God blessed them, saying 'Be fertile and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it.'" Thus, fertility is both a blessing and a command, the first blessing and the first command given to the first man and woman. The blessing and command are repeated to Noah in Genesis 9:1, as the earth is recreated after the flood. Genesis 38 contains the famous Onan passage. Onan deliberately frustrates the natural completion of the marital act, to avoid having a child by his brother's widow. "What he did greatly offended the Lord, and the Lord took his life" (9-10). There are few examples in Scripture where God directly intervenes to take a life. Onan, the contraceptive, is one of the few. In Exodus, the Egyptians, who represent the world of sin, try to enforce population control on the prolific Israelites. And what reward do the midwives receive when they refuse to cooperate with Pharaoh? God "built up families for them" (Exodus 1:21). In the Sinai Covenant, one of the blessings the Hebrews will receive for obedience to the Law is fruitfulness; one of the curses for disobedience is barrenness (Ex. 23:26). The Old Testament attitude is summarized in Psalm 127:3: "Behold, children are a gift from the Lord; the fruit of the womb is a reward."
