

The marriage rate in 1968 was 10.3 per 1,000 couples. In 2010, it was 6.8

In 1970, there were 426,000 Catholic marriages in the U.S. In 2015, there were 151,000.

In 1960, the birth rate was 24 per 1,000. In 2016 it was 12.

In 1968, 7% of families were single-parent families. Today that number is 25%.

In 2015, 8% of Catholics considered using contraceptives to be morally wrong.

In 2016, 51% of Catholics considered abortion to be morally wrong.


