



SETON SPIRIT WEEK

MON-NOV. 12- Jersey Day-IN UNIFORM DAY – Students wear their favorite team jersey/sports gear over uniform (hat, jersey, sports shirts, sweatshirts, socks, tie, hair accessories, jewelry, belt – NO face paint) Items are to be worn AFTER Monday Mass.

TUES-NOV. 13-Tacky Tuesday-OUT OF UNIFORM DAY – Students wear tacky, wacky attire, goofy hair styles, mismatched socks, shoes.

WED-NOV. 14-Beach Day-IN UNIFORM DAY-Students wear beach shirts, hats, sun glasses, floaties, closed back sandals (no flip flops) Beach attire needs to be taken off during Holy Hour.

THURS-NOV.15-Generations Day -OUT OF UNIFORM – Students wear clothing associated with the specific phase in life (make-up allowed to age your face, grey your hair, add rosy cheeks). **7th, 8th and 9th Grade**-Baby Phase: dress like a baby (bibs, pacifiers, rattlers, teddy bear). **10th, 11th and 12th Grade**-Senior Citizens-dress like Grandma and Grandpa (canes, glasses).

FRI-NOV. 16-Class Color Day-IN UNIFORM DAY-Students wear class shirts over uniforms and class color accessories (socks, ties, belts, hair accessories, jewelry, scarf/bandana). Class shirts will be removed during Mass. No face paint but face tape/stickers are allowed during the class song presentations.

Please note: On out of uniform days-clothing must be worn under onesies. NO jeans, shorts, roller skates/shoes, hair dye or face paint. Athletic (adidas) pants, loose PJ pants/sweat pants are allowed.
