

**MARIAN LENT—MARY THE WARRIOR QUEEN, Part III:** Our Lady of Covadonga. I can't resist one more story on this theme, a story much beloved by my husband, Dr. Carroll.

In 711, Muslim invaders crossed into Spain and defeated and killed the Catholic king at the Battle of the Guadalete River. Soon, most of Spain had been conquered. A nobleman named Pelayo escaped from the Muslims and gathered the remnants of the army at Covadonga in the Asturias Mountains, a tiny enclave in the north that the Muslims had hitherto ignored. The men elected Pelayo king and swore the Oath of Covadonga, vowing never to give up until Catholic Spain was free once again.

The Muslims finally took note of Pelayo and sent a renegade bishop, Bishop Oppas, to convince Pelayo to surrender. Bishop Oppas gave the usual arguments: Everyone else has given up; you're recklessly throwing away your lives to no purpose; the Muslims will reward you; you are too few to make a difference. Pelayo responded by quoting the parable of the mustard seed. He said: "This little mountain will be the salvation of Spain."

Bishop Oppas reported on his visit, and the Muslims decided to put an end to this upstart resistance. A Muslim cavalry force came into the mountains. In a cave was a statue of the Blessed Mother, Our Lady of Covadonga, saved from the Muslim assault. Pelayo and his men prayed to her for victory.

Pelayo and his men ambushed the attacking force by rolling boulders down the mountain, knocking many horses and riders over the side. They fired arrows and threw spears. The decimated Muslim army fled. Pelayo credited his victory to Our Lady's intercession.

The Muslims decided they could safely ignore Pelayo and his men. A Muslim chronicler dismissed them saying, "What are 30 barbarians perched on a rock? They will inevitably perish."

The Battle of Covadonga in 722 was the beginning of a 770-year-long war as the Catholics slowly but surely drove the Muslims from Spain. The final victory came in 1492, under the great Queen Isabel. Spain went on to be a powerful nation, which colonized and converted much of the New World, bringing millions of people to the true Faith.

When we hear arguments similar to those of the Bishop to Pelayo, as we often do, let us pray to Our Lady of Victory and remember the parable of the mustard seed.
