





**SAVE THE DATE:** Sunday, May 5, is our annual family pilgrimage to the Shrine of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton in Emmitsburg, MD. This pilgrimage is always a highlight of the year: an opportunity for many graces and for fellowship with other Seton families. Here are some details:

We have Mass at 11:00 AM at the basilica at the shrine, which is located just off Route 15. Plan to say the joyful mysteries of the Rosary on the way to the shrine. We will say the luminous mysteries as a group in the shrine about 10:30 AM. After Mass we will have a picnic at the park near the shrine. Each family should bring its own picnic lunch. After the picnic there will be time for games and socializing. We then go to the Grotto of Our Lady of Lourdes, where we conclude our day by praying the sorrowful mysteries on the Rosary Walk at 3:00 PM. Plan to say the glorious mysteries on the way home.

Sunday dress for Mass, please. You may change into casual, modest clothes for the picnic. Bring sports equipment if you like.

Emmitsburg is about a two hour drive from Manassas via Rt. 234 and Rt. 15 north. Or you can GPS your own route.

This pilgrimage is a joy-filled event, and I hope to see you there.

Let us stand with Mary at the foot of the Cross and grow more deeply in love with Jesus during the coming days, to know that when it seems that the presence of God is very far from us, He is actually very near, if only we see with the eyes of Mary's Faith.



*It was her chosen part to only stand  
In silence, seeing Him, to be so strong  
She could endure, not her wounds, but His own,  
That she could bear His cross that was not hers.  
And in another side of mystery  
Made one in her, the exquisite and endless  
Knowing held, that He was God! She saw  
The spittle wet upon His face, the bruise  
Still dark where they had struck Him; she could find  
His tattered knees, and marked the soil and streak  
Of dirt upon Him, left there from the reeling  
Moment when He'd sprawled along the road.  
She saw the scorn, the slime of all degrading,  
The contempt, the loathsomeness of Him.  
She heard them laughing at His twisted feet,  
And quarreling about a robe they'd stripped  
From Him since they had dug Him past the use  
Or need of it. And calmly, certainly,  
In simple knowledge as a mind might see
