FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

WELCOME TO SETON'S 45TH YEAR! Many thanks to our families for taking the time to fill out the Parent Survey. Almost 80 per cent of our families filled out the survey, a completion rate almost unheard of for a survey of this type. We appreciated the many positive comments but also the suggestions for improvements. We will take these suggestions to heart. To begin with, parents suggested more professional development opportunities for teachers. We have therefore scheduled a professional development day for our teachers directed by Sister Elizabeth Anne, O.P., of the Nashville Dominicans, who has years of experience in mentoring teachers. The program will integrate spiritual formation with professional formation. The program will be held on Monday, November 11. In order to take full advantage of Sister's expertise, the program will be daylong. Students will have a day off, and thus be able to spend the Veterans' Day holiday with their families.


SETON THEATRE NEWS
