THE UNIVERSAL CALL TO HOLI-

NESS: This year in senior religion class, we are devoting Tuesday to growth in the spiritual life. During the second half of the class, we have a chapel visit, with students planning the visit. During the first half, we have a lesson in spiritual formation. I am going to share a brief highlight of the lesson each week for those who would like to join the seniors in advancing in the spiritual life. The first

week's lesson is on the Universal Call to Holiness.

In his apostolic letter Novo Millennio Ineunte (At the Beginning of the New Millennium), Pope St. John Paul the Great states that the "objective gift of holiness is offered to all the baptized....Since Baptism is a true entry into the holiness of God through incorporation into Christ and the indwelling of his Spirit, it would be a contradiction to settle for a life of mediocrity, marked by a minimalist ethic and a shallow religiosity." He tells the faithful to "put out into the deep" (Duc in altum), the deep of the interior life, there to encounter Jesus Christ. We sometimes think that the interior spiritual life is just for priests and nuns, or for people who have nothing else do. St. John Paul makes it clear that Jesus is calling all of us to be forever growing more in love with our all-loving God.
