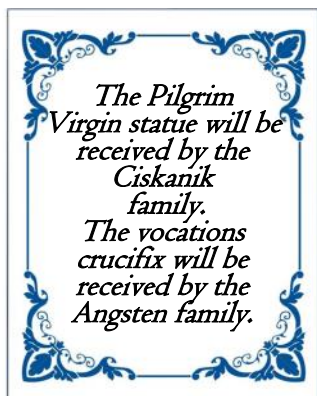

GROWING IN THE SPIRITUAL LIFE: Five Loaves and Two Fish by Cardinal Francis Xavier Nguyen Van Thuan, “The Second Loaf: Choosing God and Not God’s Works.”

Before he was arrested Cardinal Van Thuan presided over a flourishing diocese and he reveled in his many accomplishments. Suddenly it was all taken from him, and he was in a state of despair. Then he heard a voice saying, “Choose God and not God’s works.” He realized that instead of worrying about the works, he should endeavor to live each day loving God in whatever situation he was in. The chapter describes the solitary confinement cell where he spent 100 days: so humid mushrooms grew on the bed; so little air that he had to lie on the floor near a crack under the door to breath; where insects like millipedes crawled in from outside; where he had no human contact. There he had no works, but only God. But God was enough.



When our lives are not going the way we had hoped, we turn to God and accept, in the words of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, “His will of the present moment”.
