

**GROWING IN THE SPIRITUAL LIFE:** *Five Loaves and Two Fish* by Cardinal Francis Xavier Nguyen Van Thuan, "The Third Loaf: Prayer as a Fixed Point of Reference."

In the midst of his physical and mental sufferings, Cardinal Van Thuan found consolation and strength in prayer. He told the story of old Jim, who would go to the church each day and say this prayer: "Hello, Jesus. It's me, Jim." Near the end of his life, when he was hospitalized, each day Jesus would visit him in the hospital and say, "Hello, Jim. It's Me, Jesus." Cardinal Francis frequently used that simple prayer to bring himself closer to Jesus. He also liked to pray short prayers from the Gospels (Magnificat, Father into your hands, I commend my spirit, remember me when you come into your kingdom...). He also sang hymns as he paced up and down in his cell to give his body needed exercise.

We can use these simple prayers when it is difficult to concentrate or we are in the middle of a busy day or overwhelmed by problems. These prayers will bring us into the presence of Jesus so that He can strengthen and give us peace.
