

# Seton School Class Scheduling Form GUIDE for Rising Sophomores

Put your name and grade on the form.

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## **Religion**

Check HAD for Religion 9 and Check WANT for Religion 10. If you homeschooled Religion 9, please check the HAD box and put this information in the Note field. Make sure you provide Mrs. McIntyre with your transcript when you have finished the class. You will not be allowed to move to Religion 10 until we receive this transcript. See the handbook for what is required. (This also applies to all the following subject areas.)

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## **English**

Check HAD for Grammar 9 and English 9. If you tested out of Grammar 9, please make note of this in the NOTE field. Although you will not get a credit for this class, you will only be required to have 5 English credits instead of the 6 required for graduation. Please wait until you have gone through the entire form before you check any electives (such as Speech and Writing for Publication).

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## **Social Studies**

Your only choices for SS as a sophomore are WHI or WHII. Sophomores are not eligible for the other courses unless you have already taken WHII (which you will then be eligible for WHIII). Since you need 3 SS credits for graduation it would be good to have at least one SS taken by sophomore year.

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## **Mathematics**

Most of you will have taken Algebra I and some Geometry. Please mark those courses you've taken and select the next course you're eligible for. All students should take a math their sophomore year. If you have homeschooled a math course, please let us know in the note field. Per our handbook, if you homeschooled a math class you need to take our final exam in that subject area to receive credit and to move onto the next level of math. Please contact Mr. Scheetz at pscheetz@setonschool.net to setup a date/time to take the exam. You will not be allowed to move to the next level if you have not met these requirements. In addition, a 77%+ average is required in the previous level to proceed to the next level; students that receive below a 77% can complete remedial work during the summer. Mr. Scheetz is the Math Department head and can help answer your questions.

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## **Science**

Indicate the science class(es) you have taken. Make sure you are meeting the pre-requisites. For example, if you want to take Chemistry you need to also be taking Algebra II (or have taken). You need 3 science credits for graduation so it's important that you have taken at least one science class by sophomore year.

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## **Foreign Languages**

Indicate the foreign language class(es) you have taken. It is important to take these classes concurrently to maintain continuity. So, if you have taken Spanish I, then you need to sign up for Spanish II. The same is true for German and French. If you have taken Latin I and do not want to continue with Latin, then please consider moving to your language of choice. Everyone should be taking a language their sophomore year.

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## **Fine Arts and Electives**

This is the area where we don't require you to take a certain elective; however, all students will have to take some electives to meet the 26 credits required for graduation. Go back and count how many classes you have signed up for thus far in the WANT column. All students need 7 classes for a full course load. If your count is at 6, then you have one elective to choose from. This elective can come from this Fine Arts section, Speech, Writing for Publication, Computers, or any other area. Mark the elective you want and next to it put a 1 in the choice line. Now go and find a few more and number them in choice order. **It is so important that we know what you want in case you don't get your first choice.** If you have a conflict and you did not give us any choices, we will pick one for you.

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## **Sign, Save, and Email**

Have your parents look over your choices and sign the form (they can type in their name in the box provided), note any special requests or comments in the area provided or in the specific Note section of each subject area. If you would like to setup a phone meeting with Mrs. Montavon, please check the box provided to request a meeting. Once you have completed everything and your form looks good, SAVE your form: go to File > Save > PDF > select where you want to save it and save it as "Grade\_Lastname, Firstname", click on Save.
