

SETON SPANISH STUDENTS SCORE WELL

Congratulations to thirty-two Seton Spanish students who attained national recognition for excellent performance on the 2020 National Spanish Examinations.

"Attaining a medal or honorable mention for any student on the National Spanish Examinations is very prestigious," said Kevin Cessna-Buscemi, National Director of the Exams, "because the exams are the largest of their kind in the United States with over 140,000 students registered in 2020."

Students from Seton School have distinguished themselves with three-year history of high achievement on these exams and were taught by Spanish teacher Ann Martella.

The National Spanish Examinations are sponsored by the American Association of Teachers of Spanish and Portuguese.
