





SETON IS PROUD TO ANNOUNCE ITS 2020 FALL PLAY - LIVE ON STAGE!



Thanks to the amazing hard work and dedication of over 50 students, staff members and volunteers, Seton's "The Show Must Go On" promises to be an incredible success! This hilarious, fast-paced, full length original comedy will keep you on the edge of your seat as you watch Seton students overcome incredible and often ridiculous challenges to provide great entertainment under extraordinary circumstances. A blend of clever writing, great acting, high-tech wizardry and more promises a show like you've never seen. Everything goes LIVE at 6:30 PM, Sunday, November 15th, one performance only.

There are three options to watch the show - one is very different than the others, so buckle your seat belts!

For only \$2 per seat, we will print out a life size picture of your face and put it in the audience in a seat. Then, when the camera cuts to the audience, we'll see you and your friends and know that you supported this fantastic program. If we are able to live stream a cast mass prior to the show, Premium supporters will receive the link as well as watch the test streams prior to us going live - it's a little like having an all access backstage pass, but from your couch!
