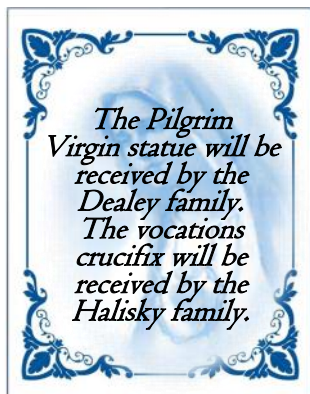

VIVA CRISTO REY! We are celebrating and preparing for the Solemnity of Christ the King on Sunday with a triduum. We begin today with our annual Christ the King Mass and Eucharistic Procession. The government is not allowing our full school procession, but Father Moretti, two dozen Seton students, and our Eucharistic King will

process in public along Quarry and Maple, climaxing with adoration and Benediction in the John Paul the Great Center. Tomorrow the students will celebrate in their Spirit Assembly. Finally, on Saturday evening, there will be a Christ the King celebration for the high school students. This celebration will include adoration in the Chapel of Our Lady Queen of the Angels.

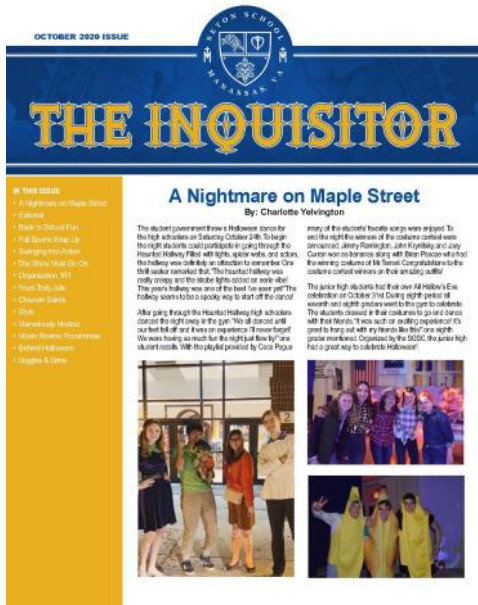
