The letter of recommendation will be sent to each institution to which you apply for admission. (Also, please indicate if there is information you do not want us to share.)

You may also wish to write additional information to describe yourself. The more adjectives, descriptions and anecdotes, the better we can advocate for you!

1. What is your legacy? For example: What are your accomplishments and the activities of which you are most proud?
2. What sets you apart from every other student? *Identify and explain the factors that make you unique and different!* Be specific with examples and/or anecdotes
3. What do you value? Give examples of how this value has meaning in your life.
4. Choose three adjectives that describe you and cite examples or anecdotes. Ask your family or friends to describe you or recall an event that helped define you.
5. Has any summer experience, work, study or travel experience been of significant importance to you and why?
6. What is your favorite book, film, music, or artwork. How has this influenced you?
7. What academic course has been your favorite and why?
8. What course has been your least favorite and why?
9. What circumstances, if any, have interfered with your academic performance?
10. If not included in questions above, what else would you like your counselor and prospective college, vocational or technical schools to know about you?
