

**LENT WITH ST. JOSEPH:** Each week during Lent, I will provide a short excerpt from the book *The Mystery of Joseph* by Marie-Dominique Philippe, O.P. This week's excerpt is from the section "Joseph, Son of David, Spouse of Mary."

"Joseph is the son of David by royal descent, but he acquires a new and personal dignity when he becomes the husband of Mary. Scripture tells us nothing about how Joseph and Mary came to meet. How did Joseph discover her and come to love her? How did Mary come to accept his choice of

her as his bride? How did she agree to be 'betrothed' to him? Naturally, this providential encounter willed by God. . [allowed] there to be a true and personal choice of reciprocal love between Joseph and Mary. They chose each other freely, loving each other and discovering, in this encounter, the providential action of God in each of their lives.

"No other two persons have ever known an encounter so profound, of such simplicity and such intensity of love—a love which was, above all, divine, yet which did not destroy the human love which united them. Saint Thomas has no hesitation in saying that there was a true marriage between Joseph and Mary because there existed between them 'an inseparable union of souls.""
