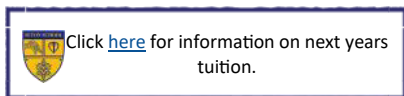

LENT WITH ST. JOSEPH, fifth installment: This week's excerpt from Fr. Philippe's book, *The Mystery of Joseph*, is from the section "Joseph and the Nativity in Bethlehem." Joseph and Mary are required to leave their home and travel to Bethlehem for the census. Joseph bears this sacrifice with Mary, "and they will be all the more united given that nothing other than their mutual love will be the milieu that will welcome their son, the Son of God." In Bethlehem, there will be "no room for them in the inn." "This indifference. . . becomes the occasion for a new intimacy between Joseph and Mary. Indeed, it is thanks to this indifference that Joseph is left alone with Mary and that, with her, he is the only witness of the mystery of the birth of God made man. . . Joseph lives together with Mary this silent, maternal liturgy of the first Christmas."
