

LENT WITH ST. JOSEPH, sixth installment: This week's excerpt from Fr. Philippe's book, *The Mystery of Joseph*, is from the section "Sanctification Through Work." By not wasting time, by remaining focused on his work, by not being excitable or chatty, nor proud or possessive, Joseph performed his work with love. He thus shows us that the Church began with the sanctification of work. He teaches us to make work a means for our sanctification, since through work we cooperate with the Father's will for us. Work allows us to manifest our love for the Father and our desire to glorify Him. Once again, whether our work be manual work or intellectual work is of little importance; this is not what counts in God's eyes. What is important is that we perform it in this spirit, namely, with the desire of glorifying the Father and loving Him through and in our work" as St. Joseph did and as he taught Jesus to do.


