First, get to know the saints and honor them—your baptismal saint, your confirmation saint, saints with special associations to your family (ethnicity, occupation, geographical areas, and so on). Second, adopt traditions from your family's past or the area of the world of your heritage. Third, celebrate the liturgical year. 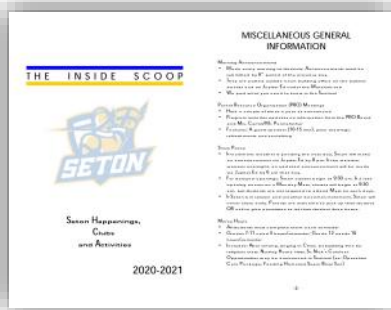
