WISDOM FROM FATHER KOEHR: For the next few weeks, I will be sharing with you the talks Father Sean Koehr (Seton 2008) gave at the faculty retreat on August 25. I hope you will find them as inspiring as we did. The first excerpts will be from Father's talk on prayer.

Jesus said to His Apostles on the night before He died: "I give you a new commandment...love one another as I have

loved you." A beautiful quote, but then we consider how he loved us—enough to give His life for us. We think: There's no way I can do that.

That's true, but it's also true that God never gives a command without giving us the capacity, the resources to fulfill the command. Where do we get the resources? Through prayer. "Those who pray will be saved; those who don't will be lost..." - St. Alphonsus Liguori.

What is prayer? Prayer – God's intense desire for us meeting our intense desire for him. Sometimes we either don't know his desire for us, or we don't know our own desire for him. We all have a desire for infinite joy that we did not give to ourselves, that nothing will satisfy except the infinite God.

Many of us spend our lives looking for a finite good to fill an infinite desire...job, spouse, exercise, entertainment, wealth, power, honor, pleasure...it's never enough...we can get drunk on these things for a while, but when we sober up we realize they promised us something they could not give. We end up hating the things we thought could fill us.

When you pray, God makes you aware that there is nothing in the world more precious to him than you. God fills us in a way that enables us to share the joy we get from prayer in every area of life. It's only when we receive God's love in prayer that we are able to give it. "Love one another as I have loved you." Only loved people love people. (to be continued)

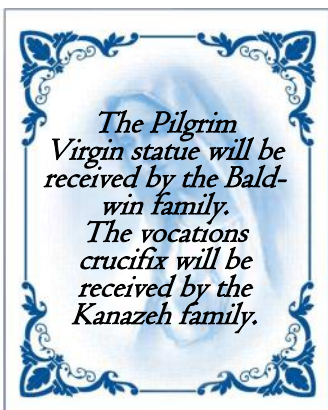
