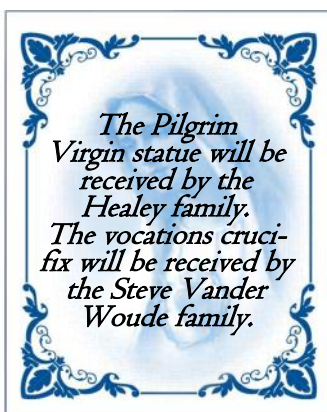

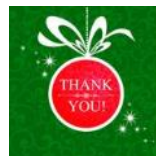

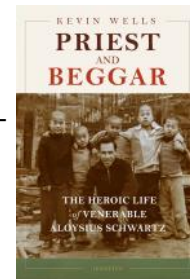


FROM OUR DIRECTOR, MR. BOB PENNEFATHER

As we celebrate the feast of the Epiphany, Father Al exemplifies one of the most concrete ways we can give to the Child Jesus by seeing Him in the faces of the poor. Here is an excerpt from Priest and Beggar, The Heroic Life of Venerable Aloysius Schwartz:



It is easy almost unconsciously to fall into the error of thinking that poverty is mostly statistics, facts, and figures. Poverty is more than this; it is above all people. Poverty has a human face and a human heart. True, its face is not always pretty to look at. And at times its heart, too, is badly scarred, even twisted. But until we get into the habit of looking poverty squarely in the face and seeing there the image of the Poor-man of Nazareth we are approaching the problem in some-thing less than a Christian manner.
