**MARY BUSER, R.I.P.** Mary Buser, who recently died after a valiant battle against cancer, was the mother of seven Seton alumni and grandmother of eight current Seton students (so far). Mary and her husband Don moved to this area so that they could send their children to Seton. This was, to put it mildly, a leap of faith. Seton at that time had one small building (long since demolished), which the fire marshal told us would burn in 30 seconds. The classes were in single digits, as was the number of staff. We didn't have much to offer in any worldly sense, but the Busers weren't interested in worldly values. They were interested in a Catholic education for their children, but the Buser family gave far more than they received. Seton is what it is today due in large part to the foundations laid by the Buser family. Mary was Seton's first PRO President. (Her daughter, Maria Hartung, is our current PRO President.) She worked tirelessly to make Seton better during the years her children attended, from Michael '82 to Fran '93. She was a devoted wife and mother, whose Catholic faith was the priority in her life. Please pray for the repose of her soul and for strength and grace for her family.
