Launch of New Bellarmine Scholarship Fund

Three college students (Justin Bailey, Andres Donovan, and Matthew Uzdavinis) who first met while attending a Catholic high school in Florida have launched a scholarship fund to help others experience a faithful Catholic education. The Saint Robert Bellarmine Fund annually awards scholarships to 10 high school seniors who display both merit and need and wish to attend one of the Catholic colleges recognized by The Cardinal Newman Society for fidelity and strong Catholic formation. The \$8,000 scholarships are renewable for four years. The fund is guided by the Bailey Family Foundation, a philanthropy devoted to improving the availability and quality of post-secondary education.
