Benchmark Assessment for 7th & 8th Graders

The CLT8 is an online diagnostic or benchmark assessment designed for 7th and 8th graders. It can be proctored by a parent at home or taken in-school at participating institutions. The CLT8 is a popular test to measure the progress and achievement of 7th and 8th grade students.
