HONORING THE FEAST OF OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY: On October 7, the Church celebrates the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, formerly known as Our Lady of Victory. The feast was established by Pope Pius V after the Catholic victory over the Muslim Turks at the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. This battle put an end to Turkish sea power and saved Christian Europe. The Pope had requested all Catholics to pray the Rosary for victory, and the prayers were answered.



On October 15 you can participate in the Public Square Rosary Crusade. There will be over 20,000 rallies that will take place across the United States all praying the rosary in reparation for the sins and offenses committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary and for the conversion of the United States. There are two locations close to Seton that you can participate in at 12 Noon on 10/15: the corner of Hoadly Road and Purcell Road and the corner of Limestone and Linton Hall Roads (in front of Holy Trinity Church). Bring your family and join in prayer in honor of our Holy Mother.

MORE ON THE ROSARY: October is the month of the Holy Rosary. Please consider praying the Rosary as a family during the month of October. This is a good time to begin this beautiful custom.
