NOTES FROM FATHER JONATHAN SMITH'S TALK AT THE SENIOR MINI-RETREAT,

CONCLUDED: In the first installment, Fr. Smith explained the importance of forming a personal Relationship with God. In the second, he said that our true Identity is found only in God. In this final installment, we see how Relationship and Identity lead us to our Mission. If our identity is in Christ, then our mission is in Christ. The identity of Jesus Christ is that He is the Son of God. At His baptism in the Jordan, the Father proclaimed Jesus identity: "This is My Beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased." The mission of Jesus was to proclaim God as Father of us all and to preach the Good News of the Father's infinite love and mercy for us. We have received the same Holy Spirit as Jesus received at His Baptism. Our mission is the same as His: to go out to all the world and proclaim the Good News. We've been given gifts from God so that we can build up the Kingdom of God in our families and in every aspect of our lives.
