A. Eligibility

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior woman or currently enrolled in a 2-year or 4-year university pursuing a degree in education.
2. Applicant must be attending or applying to a four-year college/university
3. Applicant must be planning to enter the field of education

B. Requirements

1. Completed application should be completed online with the necessary attachments emailed to Scholarship Committee Chair, dated no later than **April 24, 2023**.
 - a. Applicants may complete a paper copy of the application but it must be scanned and emailed to the email below and received by the deadline.
2. Official transcript (scanned copy is accepted) and 2 letters of recommendation should be emailed to the Scholarship Committee Chair, **Erin Hara Anderson at erin.mh.anderson@gmail.com**

C. Procedure

1. Student will submit one completed application to the Scholarship Committee Chair at the above address emailed by Monday, April 24, 2023. Email with attachments will verify the date. Application is not considered complete without the official transcript (scanned is acceptable) and the two letters of recommendations. The two letters may be emailed directly to Erin Hara Anderson by the referents for confidentiality if they prefer.
2. Winner will be selected by Friday, April 28, 2023.
3. **Winner and parent will be invited to attend the May 18th meeting of Alpha Mu Chapter Delta Kappa Gamma. The meeting will take place at 4:30 pm at Trinity Episcopal Church located at 9325 West Street, Manassas.**
4. A check in the amount of \$1,000 will be mailed to recipient's chosen college/university upon proof of enrollment no later than June 30, 2023.
