# Youth Cadet Law Enforcement Program Opportunity

The Virginia Youth Cadet Law Enforcement Program (also known as Junior Law), sponsored by the American Legion, offers the opportunity for current juniors to learn about law enforcement responsibilities. The Virginia State Police Training Academy located in Richmond will host the annual week-long session from Sunday, June 18 to Friday, June 23. Students will participate in daily classroom and field sessions that touch on all aspects of law enforcement. Applicants should be aware that this is a high intensity and sometimes physically demanding week of learning based on the type of training received by Virginia State Police trooper candidates. Applicants should be well-rounded, out-going, hardworking students with reasonable grades who can communicate and lead their peers. The student must have a valid learner's permit or operator's license, and a copy must be attached to the application. The application form can be found here, and a brochure about the program here. Students will receive communication via email regarding scheduled interviews and progress of their applications.
