Upcycling is creative reuse; it is the process of taking something considered as "junk" and transforming it into something useful (i.e., plastic bags woven into rugs, swings made with old tires, bike racks made from scrap bike parts, and furniture crafted from shipping pallets). How can the functional objects, structures, and spaces in your community be reimaged through upcycling or what useful, upcycled product can you provide your community? Grand Prize is \$1,000. Earn College Credit with CLEP

For over 50 years, the College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) has helped students receive college credit for a fraction of the cost of a college course. The program lets students show mastery of introductory college-level material and earn credit for what they already know. Students can test out of courses and move to more advanced courses sooner, saving time toward a degree. CLEP offers 34 exams covering intro-level college course content, including College Algebra, Biology, and History of the United States. Nearly 3,000 colleges and universities grant credit for CLEP exams. Exams are scored from 20 to 80 and many colleges require a 50 score to receive credit. Students prepare for the exams on their own.
