



That "forgotten force" is the Western Christian Paideia (WCP). Paideia was described last week. "Western refers to any civilization that descends from the convergence of Greece, Rome, and Hebrew cultures, dating back roughly 2,500 years to the golden age of Greece. It envelops

nearly all historical Christendom..." Christian refers not just to personal beliefs but to the concept that Christ is King over all of society, and every aspect should be in harmony with God's law. The Left deliberately removed WCP from education and replaced it with a secular-liberal paideia. Here are a few quick comparisons: WCP: Seek wisdom. Today: Learn selected facts and opinions masquerading as facts. WCP: Learn to reason logically. Today: Accept indoctrination.

WCP: "There is a divine order, revealed in Christ." Today: "There is humanist anarchy." "The WCP's removal...from both colleges and K-12 classrooms has been carefully hidden. Make no mistake about it, the paideia of our youngest was the Progressives' ultimate prize."




