How many students attend? What is the average class size? What majors are offered? Which majors are most popular? Do you offer credit for AP Exams? What scholarships are offered? Is the college/university test optional? What careers are popular with graduates? Are opportunities available for research, independent study, and/or internships? Is there a study abroad program? What are the admission requirements? Is there a Catholic Campus Ministry? What sports and clubs are offered? Why should you consider going to the college/university?

Date Change for the FAFSA

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is used by colleges and universities to determine student eligibility for federal, state, and college-sponsored financial aid, including grants, scholarships, educational loans, and work-study programs. In the past, the FAFSA became available on October 1st. **Due to changes and improvements to the application, the 2024-2025 award year FAFSA will open this December.** The federal government and many states award financial aid on a first-come, first-served basis, so it is recommended to submit the form as soon as possible after the application becomes available.
