

## Picture Day Dress Code

STUDENTS MAY BE IN OUT OF UNIFORM DRESS CODE, AS SPECIFIED IN THE HANDBOOK. ALL STUDENTS WILL BE CHECKED FOR DRESS CODE IN HOMEROOM. STUDENTS WHO DO NOT FOLLOW DRESS CODE WILL NEED TO CHANGE BEFORE THEIR PICTURE MAY BE TAKEN

<b>DRESS CODE FOR GIRLS</b>	<b>DRESS CODE FOR BOYS</b>
<p>Girls will wear dresses or skirts with blouses or sweaters following the guidelines of Uniform Dress Code, with the following additions (no pants):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Dresses and skirts must cover the knees when standing or sitting.</li><li>• Dresses, skirts, tops, blouses or sweaters must not be short, tight, clingy, form fitting or see-through.</li><li>• Dresses/skirts: Slits or gaps above the knee are not permitted. Slits may be sewn closed.</li><li>• No pencil style or other tight skirts are allowed. No wrap-around skirts or dresses are allowed.</li><li>• Necklines in tops or dresses must not be more than two inches below the collarbone (<u>about the width of three fingers</u>) unless a turtleneck or crewneck shirt is worn under them.</li><li>• Dresses and tops must have sleeves, even if jackets or sweaters are worn. However, shirts with sleeves may be worn under sundresses, as in jumpers.</li><li>• Lingerie camisoles are not acceptable. Other camisoles must meet neckline requirements.</li><li>• Sweaters may be worn for Out-of-Uniform Class Days. Sweaters cannot be tight or low cut.</li><li>• Any dress shoes are acceptable, including dressboots. Heels must be no higher than 3 inches. Nice sneakers are allowed for picture day only.</li></ul>	<p>Boys must have dress slacks, dress shirt, and tie. Please note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Boys may also wear a sweater and/or a jacket. No hoodies.</li><li>• Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Collar buttons must be buttoned.</li><li>• Ties must be tied at the neck.</li><li>• Pants – the following are NOT permitted jeans or cargo styling, loose, dragging or tight styles.</li><li>• Belts must be worn with clothing that has belt loops.</li><li>• Shoes must be dress shoes or dress boots. Nice sneakers are allowed for picture day only.</li><li>• Boys' hair may not be more than four inches long at any point, must be above the collar, and must be neatly styled. Spiked hair is not allowed</li></ul>

Hoodies of any kind are never allowed at Seton. If in doubt, don't wear it. Please follow the rules so we can all look nice for picture day. See the Seton Handbook on the Seton School website for more dress code information.
