



INTELLECTUAL FORMATION: Here is the next take-away from The Battle for the American Mind.



Part III: "A Solution as Big as the Problem". Chapter 8: "Reason and Virtue: Two Towers of Freedom"

AMERICAN Western Christian Paideia's four core battlements: Reason, Virtue, Wonder, Beauty.

PETE HEBSETH REASON: The SAT has changed from questions that tested verbal and mathematical reasoning. Instead it tests memorization from the Com-

mon Core (the Progressive standardized curricula). The Progressives removed logic and rhetoric; stopped studying world history, philosophy, and theology; divided subjects into "silos" without a unifying factor. [Seton, of course, has done exactly the opposite.]

VIRTUE: Progressives have replaced virtue (which is objective because it is grounded in God's goodness) with "values" (which is subjective because it is grounded in the opinions of the individual and of the "elite" of society. "Virtue, properly understood, is rooted in the affections of a person as they align to God's affections." "Values are just 'things we believe." Progressives have a new set of pseudo values—diversity-equity-inclusivity—environmentalism, gender fluidity, multiculturism, sexual liberation, critical race theory. They preach tolerance, but there is nothing more intolerant than the cancel culture. "The new priests of the progressive gospel control corporations, sports teams, government bureaucracies," preaching a socially acceptable orthodoxy. [Seton, of course, teaches objective moral truth and seeks to cultivate virtue.]

2024 AP EXAM REGISTRATION IS OPEN!


Highschoolers interested in taking any 2024 AP exams may register between now and November
