A Message to the Seniors:

Regarding applying to colleges, please note the following important information:

- 1. Please notify Mr. Geary at least two weeks in advance for a Counselor Letter of Recommendation.
- 2. Even if you are applying to colleges through the Common App, you must <u>visit</u>, <u>email</u>, <u>or call</u> Mr. Geary with your request and provide a deadline for your letter. (<u>pgeary@setonschool.net</u>/703-368-9555)
- **3.** Please <u>do not</u> wait until the last minute for your request. Be courteous and look ahead at your application deadlines and request your Letter of Recommendation accordingly.
- **4.** <u>Always, always</u> put Mrs. McIntyre's name and email down (<u>tmcintyre@setonschool.net</u>) when you "Invite Counselor" in the Common App. Make sure you type in her email address correctly. Mrs. McIntyre submits the school report, transcripts, and Counselor Letters of Recommendation. Mr. Geary <u>writes</u> the Counselor Letters of Recommendation.
- 5. January 1st is the application deadline for many colleges. If you need to request your high school transcript to meet this deadline, please do so by <u>Friday, Dec. 15 before Christmas break</u>. Email Mrs. McIntyre at <u>tmcintyre@setonschool.net</u>.

2024 Virginia Summer Residential Governor's School

Virginia Summer Residential Governor's School provides current gifted sophomores and juniors with intensive educational experiences in Agriculture; Humanities; Mathematics, Science, and Technology; and through mentorships in Marine Science and Engineering. Students live on a college or university campus for up to four weeks during the summer. During this time, students are involved in classroom and laboratory work, field studies, and research with noted scholars and other professionals. A school or division selection committee chooses the nominees from each school or division and forwards the nominees to a state committee. Consideration is given to students' academic records, test scores, extracurricular activities, honors and awards, creativity, original essays, and teacher recommendations. Tuition ranges between \$975 and \$1750. While this is a fairly involved process, it has the potential of being a valuable experience! The New Digital SAT: What to Expect

The new digital SAT will be offered spring 2024 starting with the March 9 test. College Board is making a full transition to digital and will no longer offer a paper and pencil version. Key changes include:

- 1. It will be shorter (2 hours instead of 3).
- 2. Students will have more time to answer each question.
- 3. Calculators will be allowed for the entire Math section.
- 4. Reading passages will be shorter and more targeted.
- 5. Students will get scores back in days instead of weeks.
