



# Join the Seton Bowling Club & Win College Scholarships

1. The Manassas Area Student Bowling League is a High School Club Bowling League at Bowl America Bull Run. The league is a student only league and participants compete against other High School teams and you can compete to win College scholarships.
2. We are looking to form at least one team of three Seton students to compete against other Manassas area High School teams each Thursday afternoon at 4pm at Bowl America Bull Run, [10641 Balls Ford Road, Manassas, VA 20109](https://www.bowlamerica.com/locations/bull-run). I can support two teams if enough students are interested.
3. This is a 12-week league that begins on Thursday November 9th and ends on Thursday February 8th.
4. Students from 8th through 12th grade are eligible to participate. If you can't come every week, you can also join the team as a substitute bowler and have the opportunity to bowl when a regular student bowler can't make it. Substitute may not be eligible for scholarship funds.
5. Each player will have a fee of \$15 each week to play three games. The fees cover the cost to bowl, rent shoes and a nominal contribution to the League's scholarship fund. There is also a one time \$4 league sanction fee.
6. Used professional bowling balls are available to students for free, there may be costs to fit the ball to your hand. The bowling alley also has basic bowling balls that students can use free of charge.
7. Transportation (to and from Seton) and coaching support will be provided by Tommy Reynolds
8. Notionally, we will depart Seton on Thursdays at 3:15pm, games will start at 4pm, games will probably last until 5/5:30pm; students will return to Seton approximately 5:30 to 6pm or they can be picked up at Bowl America before 5pm.
9. There will be a league formation meeting on the first week of competition, Thursday November 9th at 3:45pm and they will go over the rules for the league. Parents are encouraged to attend or join Tommy at that time in a phone call to listen and ask questions.
10. Our club will run fundraisers to offset and potential cover the costs for their bowling fees or getting new bowling equipment. My goal is to make this free for the students so I will have a few fundraising opportunities for the students to cover their expenses: hold a 50/50 raffle at the Knights of Columbus Bowling League; host a fund raiser dinner at the Knights of Columbus hall on select Friday nights.
11. Please note: Students who would like to participate in this club must have parent approval and can only do so if it does not conflict with their school schedule (including homework), school sports schedule, or other Seton club schedules.
