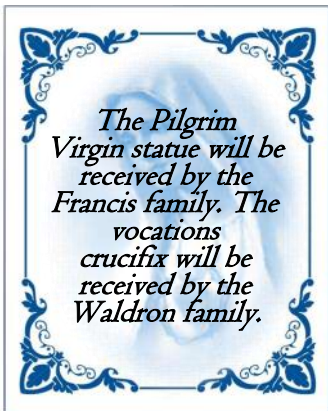

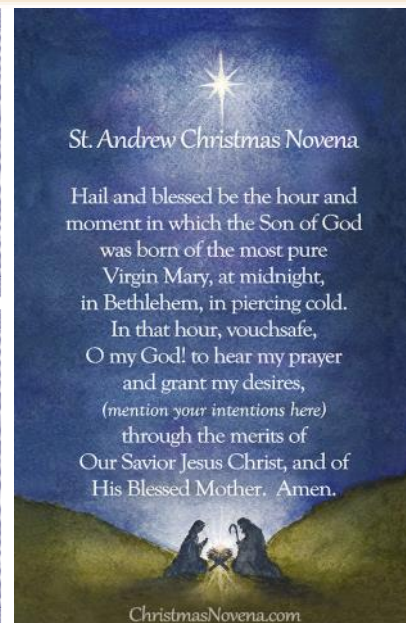
SETON IMPROV!
