University of Dallas - Annual Competition for Full-Tuition Scholarships

The Crusader Scholarship is open to all high school seniors who apply to UD. Applicants must finish their admission application by Feb. 14 and fill out the additional Crusader Scholarship application form (https://ugadmis.udallas.edu/register/crusaderscholarship). The Crusader Scholarship will recognize well-rounded students who best represent what it means to be a UD Crusader. To be eligible, students must finish their UD application and the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), meet minimum GPA and test score requirements, submit a short essay, and participate in a one-hour webinar on Feb. 29 or March 2. Five students will receive the scholarship, valued at more than \$200,000, which will cover tuition for four years.

Reminder - The SAT Goes Digital on March 9

College Board is making a full transition to digital with the March 9 SAT and will no longer offer a paper and pencil version. Key changes include:

- 1. It will be shorter (2 hours instead of 3).
- 2. Students will have more time to answer each question.
- 3. Calculators will be allowed for the entire Math section.
- 4. Reading passages will be shorter and more targeted.
- 5. Students will get scores back in days instead of weeks.
