YEAR OF PRAYER: In the past there has been a mistaken notion that mental prayer was only for priests, monks, and nuns. But the call to holiness is universal, as the Second Vatican Council and St. John Paul II told us. Others might be turned from mental prayer because

they think of it in terms of great mystical experiences. But St. Teresa of Avila told us that "mental prayer is nothing more than intimate sharing between friends; it

means taking time to be alone with Him who we know loves us." If we love someone, we want to talk to the beloved. So start that conversation. Make a resolution to set aside a certain amount of time for mental prayer each day, even if it is only five minutes, and be faithful that time, no matter what.

BIG SISTER-LITTLE SISTER—LOVE FOR THE ELDERLY

Motivation behind the event- Big Sister-Little Sister Jacob was a young boy who spent countless hours with his grandfather. Many weekends they spent together visiting the park, eating cookies and milk, vacationing together, and having sleepovers at Nana and Papi's house. Needless to say, Jacob, at 13, was crushed when he heard his grandpa died. In his memory Jacob visited an elderly home and he found himself in high

demand. They called him the "bingo boy." This statement sums up his experience, "I quickly found out the world didn't always care about them (elderly). In fact, many would tell me that I was their only visitor. They hadn't heard from family in months." After graduating from Yale, Jacob had this idea of reaching grandparents everywhere. He's the founder of Love for the Elderly. Today there's over 50,000 volunteers across 70 countries working together to fight loneliness with love letters to the elderly. On Tues, February 13th, the Big & Little Sisters spent an hour writing, drawing,



and creating personal love letters to 8 specific grandparents. I have a feeling this will be an annual event for Seton's Big Little program.
