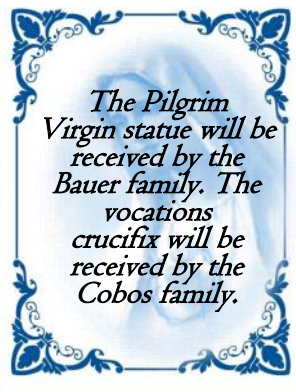

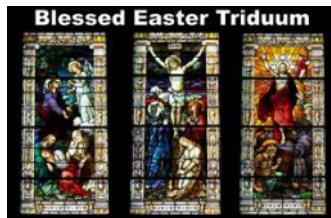


our students that these retreats will bear ongoing fruit in their lives.
